

Rules and Regulations

- 1. The Organiser reserves the right to modify or substitute any of these Rules and Regulations of the Event from time to time as they deem fit. If there is ambiguity in any of the provisions, the Organiser shall be the authority to interpret and in doing so, the Organiser will take into account the interests of all the affected Participants.
- 2. The Organiser reserves the right to prevent a participant's continuation in the race should they fail to comply with the rules and regulations.
- 3. Any disputes arising from participation in the BRT RUN 2022 shall be referred to Arbitration to be conducted in Malaysia within the Laws of Malaysia.
- 4. In response to future decisions from Malaysia authorities (if any) or in any unforeseen circumstances, the Organiser has the right to convert BRT RUN 2022 to be a virtual event. Further arrangement regarding registration will then be announced later.

Registration

- 1. All participants must submit their entries and payment online through the website below: www.racexasia.com
- 2. The Organiser shall not be responsible for any disputes arising from incomplete entry details.
- 3. All entries are based on a first-come first-serve basis unless otherwise stated. Slots are limited to 1000 participants only.
- 4. The BRT RUN 2022 is open to all Malaysian citizen who holds a valid Malaysian Passport and/or Malaysian IC and International participants with valid passport.
- 5. Age qualification is taken as at 31st December 2022
- 6. Once the registration is completed and payment has been made, entry fees for those who for whatever reason (s) do not take part in the event are NON TRANSFERABLE, NON REFUNDABLE AND NON DEFERRABLE.
- 7. Race entry is non-transferable to unregistered participants. Those who are discovered to participate with an unauthorized race number will be disqualified.
- 8. Upon confirmation of participation, change to the category or other details will not be entertained. Any change of category requires a new registration.
- 9. The Organiser reserves the right to limit, accept or reject any entries without prior notice and reasons.
- 10.The Organiser reserves the right to close entries before deadline without any notice or when the quota of a race/start is full.
- 11. Completion of the registration form is an indication of the participant's agreement to abide by the rules and regulations of the BRT RUN 2022.
- 12. Participants must agree to receive contact from the event Organiser from time to time by email/SMS blast. Any notice sent by email from The Organiser or the party assigned by

the Organiser to the supplied address on the registration form shall be assumed received by the Participant.

Race Kit Collection

1. The Race Kit collection (RKC):

Date: 29-30th July Time: 2.30pm-8pm

Venue: BRT SunU - Monash

- 2. All participants must bring along the confirmation slip or confirmation number together with their Identity Card or passport to collect their bib number and event T-shirt.
- 3. Change in sizes of the race event tee during collection is strictly NOT ALLOWED. Participants must adhere to the race event tee sizes that they have registered for.
- 4. There will be no Race-Kit collection counter opened during the race day, hence no race-kits will be issued to participants. Outstation participants are advised to choose postage option to avoid missing the actual racekit collection day.
- 5. Participants who missed the operating hours of Racekit Collection Day and still wish to participate, are able to request to collect before flag-off. RM10 per racekit will be charged as a penalty fee.
- 6. All Race kits not collected during RKC day will be kept for collection after race day. Kindly contact The Organiser for this purpose and collect within 2 weeks, else it will be deemed to be unwanted, and the Organiser shall be at liberty to dispose or re-distribute them accordingly.

During Event Day

- 1. It is compulsory for the participants to display their race number at all time during the race. Failure to comply will result in the participants' disqualification from the race.
- 2. In our efforts to promote sustainability and green society, participants are encouraged to bring your own water bottles. No paper cups will be provided at the water stations but don't worry about running out of fluids as there will be plenty of water dispensers along the way for you to refill and hydrate.
- 3. All participants are encouraged to wear the BRT RUN 2022 event t-shirt during the race.
- 4. Participants must run on the designated path for the entire route. Failure to do so will result in disqualification.
- 5. Participants who take part are required to keep to the left side of the lane so as not to cause obstruction to other participants.
- 6. No pets or any form of wheel-run objects of transport e.g. inline skates, prams, push cars, shoes with built-in or attached rollers are allowed on the course other than official race and medical vehicles.
- 7. Sweeper vehicles will be mobilized to pick up participants after cut-off time for each category. Participants are encouraged to board the sweeper vehicles.

- 8. Whilst every reasonable precaution will be taken by the Organiser to ensure participants' safety, participants partake in this event at their own risks and the Organiser, their sponsors and their appointed officials shall not be liable for any death or injury, loss or damage, suffered or otherwise and howsoever arising.
- 9. The Organiser reserves the right to remove any participant deemed physically incapable of continuing with the race to prevent him/her from causing greater harm and injury to himself / herself.
- 10. The Organiser reserves the right to cancel, postpone or change the event date or venue at their own discretion. No refunds will be given if this event is cancelled by unavoidable means from the orders of Organiser.
- 11. The Organiser reserves the right to delay the commencement of the race in the event of inclement weather or any form of acts of God. Should the mentioned persist after the delay, deemed to be unsafe or impossible to proceed, the Organiser reserves the right to cancel the race without any refunds of fees or donations paid unless the Organiser have considerations to give a refund and The Organiser shall not be held liable for any loss or inconvenience caused.
- 12. The Organiser reserves the right to use any photographs (including those of participants), motion pictures, recordings, or any other record of this event for any legitimate purpose, including commercial advertising.

Adhering the SOPs

Safety measures for protecting runners from exposure to Covid-19, each participant must:

- 1. Be fully vaccinated.
- 2. Wear a face mask before and after the run.
- 3. Always comply to the latest SOP by Kementerian Kesihatan Malaysia (KKM) throughout the event.

Race Results

- 1. Winners must wear the official event t-shirt during prize giving ceremony
- 2. Finisher's medal will be awarded to participant that completed the run within qualifying time of each category.
- 3. For age verification and Identification, proof such as ID card or passport is required for all claims of winner's cash prizes.
- 4. Any protests on the official result, kindly write in with evidence to The Organiser within 30 minutes once the result is announced with protest fees RM200 in cash (protest fees is non-refundable).
