

Rules & Regulations

Please read these Terms and Conditions (“**Terms**”) carefully. By registering for the MAPPAC Family Walk 2025, which will be held between 7:00 AM and 11:00 AM on 24th May 2025 (“**the Event**”), each participant (or, where applicable, the parent, guardian, or legal representative of a participant under 18 years old) (“**Participant**”) acknowledges that they have read, understood, and agreed to be bound by these Terms.

Organiser & Eligibility

1. The Event is organised by the Malaysian Association of Paediatric Palliative Care (“**Organiser**”).
2. Eligibility:
 - a) The Event is open to all Malaysian residents (both Malaysians and non-Malaysians) with no minimum age limit. Participation is entirely voluntary.
 - b) Participants under 18 years old (“**Young Participants**”) must be accompanied by at least one (1) adult Participant aged 18 or above (“**Guardian**”). The Guardian assumes full responsibility for the Young Participant’s safety, and the Organiser shall not be liable for any accident, injury, or other incidents involving the Young Participant.

Participant Registration & Personal Data Use

3. By registering for the Event, the Participant agrees that: -
 - a) The Organiser may collect and use Personal Data for the purpose of managing the Event, including event-related communications such as emails, SMS, WhatsApp messages, or phone calls.
 - b) The Organiser may engage third-party service providers to process registration and facilitate event logistics. Such third parties are contractually bound to use the data only for event purposes.
 - c) The Participant has the right, at any time, to: -
 - i. withdraw their consent to data processing;
 - ii. correct or update their personal data; and / or
 - iii. raise any concerns regarding their personal data by contacting the Organiser via mappac.events@gmail.com (“**Official Email**”).
 - d) The Organiser shall take reasonable precautions to protect Participants’ personal data and will not retain it longer than necessary.
 - e) Data may be disclosed if required by law or government authorities.

Liability & Responsibility

4. The Organiser declares that, by virtue of being the Organiser, it may engage the services of third parties at any time as deemed necessary.

5. Participants must ensure that they are medically fit to participate in the Event. The Organiser shall not be liable for any accident or mishap arising from a Participant's non-disclosure of medical conditions.
6. The Organiser reserves the right to modify or substitute any of the rules and regulations of the Event as deemed necessary. In the event of any ambiguity in the provisions, the Organiser shall have the sole authority to interpret them, taking into account the interests of all affected Participants. Any updates to the rules and regulations will be communicated via the Official Website at <https://mappac.org>.
7. The completion and submission of the online registration form through the Event Registration Portal (**RaceXAsia**) constitutes the Participant's agreement to abide by the rules and regulations set by the Organiser. Upon successful registration, a Confirmation Slip will be sent to the email address provided during registration. If a Participant does not receive the Confirmation Slip, they must notify the RaceXAsia via their email <info@racexasia.com> **within five (5) working days**. Any discrepancies in the Confirmation Slip must also be reported to RaceXAsia within the same timeframe.
8. The Confirmation Slip is the only valid proof of confirmed registration and must be presented during the Event registration process.
9. Each Participant must provide true, accurate, current, and complete information during registration. The Organiser may contact the Participant via email as necessary. Any notices sent to the email address provided during registration shall be deemed received by the Participant. If any information provided is found to be false, inaccurate, outdated, or incomplete, or if the Organiser has reasonable grounds to suspect so, the Organiser reserves the right to suspend or terminate the Participant's registration and prohibit any current or future participation in events organised by the Organiser.
10. Once a Participant's registration has been duly processed, no refunds will be provided if the Participant does not participate in the Event for any reason.
11. The Organiser shall not be responsible for any disputes arising from incomplete or inaccurate details submitted in the registration form and will not entertain any related claims.
12. Participants are strictly prohibited from transferring their Event entries to another party.
13. The Organiser reserves the right to change the Event date, venue, or cancel the Event at any time without prior notice. In such cases, the Organiser will make reasonable efforts to inform Participants in advance. If the Event is cancelled, no refunds will be provided, and the Organiser shall not be liable for any losses or inconveniences caused. Any updates, including changes to these Terms, will be posted on the Event's Official Website, and it is the Participant's responsibility to stay informed.
14. No refunds will be issued if the Event is cancelled due to force majeure, including but not limited to haze, storms, heavy rain, inclement weather, strong winds, acts of God, terrorism, or any other conditions beyond the Organiser's control that, in the Organiser's opinion, render it impossible or unsafe to proceed with the Event.
15. The Organiser reserves the right to delay the commencement of the Event in the case of adverse weather conditions such as heavy rain, thunderstorms, or extreme weather. If the condition persists, the Organiser may cancel the Event without any refund of registration fees. In the event

of a natural disaster or any catastrophic occurrence leading to postponement or cancellation, the Organiser shall not be held responsible for any claims or liabilities arising from such cancellation.

16. The Organiser reserves the right to limit and / or refuse entry to any Participant without providing any reason or prior notice. Additionally, the Organiser has the absolute discretion to exclude or disqualify any Participant whom it deems to be acting in a manner contrary to the interests of the Organiser or the Event, or in violation of these Terms.
17. On the Event Date, each Participant will receive a MAPPAC Badge ("**the Badge**") upon registration. The Participant must wear the Badge at all times during the Event for identification purposes and to participate in Event activities and / or be entitled to a goodie bag. The Organiser reserves the right to bar any Participant who is not wearing the Badge from participating in any or all Event activities or deny their entitlement to a goodie bag.
18. The Organiser reserves the right to amend the Event's walking route ("**Route**") at its discretion for the safety of Participants or to mitigate potential hazards. Any such changes may be made at any time without prior notice. However, the Organiser will make reasonable efforts to inform Participants before the Event Date. Updates regarding route changes will be posted on the Event's Official Website, and it is the Participant's responsibility to stay informed. The Organiser shall not be liable for any loss or inconvenience caused by such changes.
19. While the Organiser will take all reasonable precautions to ensure the safety of Participants, participation in the Event is entirely at the Participant's own risk. The Organiser shall not be responsible or liable for any injury, death, damage, or loss of property, whether personal or otherwise, arising in connection with participation in the Event. Participants are strongly advised to undergo a medical examination and / or consult their medical practitioner before registering for the Event.
20. The Route will not be guarded by route marshals 90 minutes after the official flag-off time ("**Closure Time**"). Any Participants still on the Route or who choose to continue walking beyond Closure Time do so at their own risk. Additionally, Participants who do not start within 30 minutes of the official flag-off time may be disallowed from joining the walk for safety reasons.
21. Participants must follow the designated Route and comply with the instructions of route marshals, Event officers, and / or enforcement officials at all times.
22. Participants must immediately withdraw from the Event if instructed to do so by any member of the Event's official medical staff, the Event Director, or a security officer.
23. For safety reasons, pets, bicycles, prams, pushcarts, strollers, inline skates, shoes with built-in or attached rollers, and any other wheeled objects are strictly prohibited on the Route.
24. The Organiser reserves the right to capture and use any photographs, motion pictures, recordings, or other media records taken during the Event, including images of Participants, for legitimate purposes, including but not limited to commercial advertising and distribution to sponsors, without compensation or prior notice.
25. The Organiser shall not be responsible for any loss, injury, or claims arising from the use of either sponsored or non-sponsored products and services.
26. All Participants who successfully register and complete the Event will be awarded an electronic finisher's certificate ("**the Certificate**"). The Certificate will be emailed to the Participant within thirty (30) days after the Event Date. If there are any discrepancies in the Certificate, the

Participant must notify the Organiser via the Official Email within ten (10) days from the publication date.

27. By electronically agreeing to these Terms during the registration process on the Event Registration Portal, the Participant acknowledges that they have read, understood, and agreed to be bound by the Terms.
28. The Participant fully accepts and acknowledges that participating in the Event involves inherent risks and dangers, some of which may not be readily foreseeable, including but not limited to personal injury, death, or damage to property.
29. In consideration of being allowed to participate in the Event, as registered through the Event Registration Portal, the Participant, on behalf of themselves and their personal representatives, agrees as follows: -
 - a) The Participant fully and unconditionally releases the Organiser, RaceXAsia, sub-contractors, all municipal agencies whose property or personnel are used, all sponsoring and co-sponsoring companies or individuals related to the Event, and their respective employees, agents, volunteers, and affiliates (collectively, the “**Releasees**”) from any and all liability, including negligence. This includes, but is not limited to, negligent rescue operations, and is intended to be as broad and inclusive as permitted under Malaysian law.
 - b) The Participant expressly waives the right to initiate any legal proceedings against the Releasees for any claims, demands, losses, or damages arising from or in connection with their participation in the Event, including but not limited to personal injury, death, or property damage, whether caused by negligence or otherwise.
 - c) The Participant warrants that they are in good physical condition, have undertaken sufficient preparation, and are able to safely participate in the Event. The Participant acknowledges and accepts all inherent risks and hazards associated with participation, including the possibility of serious physical trauma, injury, or death.
 - d) The Participant grants the Organiser the right to use any photographs, motion pictures, recordings, or other media captured during the Event in which they appear, for any legitimate purpose, including promotional and commercial use, without compensation or prior notice.
 - e) The Participant agrees to accept promotional materials and / or items from the Organiser as part of their participation in the Event.
 - f) The Participant acknowledges that all registration fees and transaction costs (if applicable) are strictly non-refundable, non-transferable, and non-deferrable under any circumstances.
 - g) The Participant acknowledges that the Organiser reserves the right to modify, alter, cancel, and / or postpone the Event due to unforeseen circumstances beyond the Organiser’s control that may directly impact the Event.
30. The Organiser reserves the absolute right to determine the presentation and distribution of prizes for activities within the Event. All prizes are awarded on an “as is” basis and are strictly non-exchangeable for cash, credit, vouchers, or other items, in whole or in part.

31. All winners must adhere to the terms and conditions set by the respective sponsors or entities providing the prizes, including any additional conditions attached to the prizes, if applicable.
